RULES & REGULATIONS FOR NETOOK GLIDING CENTRE APRIL 2011

- Squadron Officers are to be in attendance and exercise proper control of cadets at all times. This normally includes the sports, classroom exercises, etc at the domestic site, and cadets at the gliding operation site.
- REMEMBER: This facility is designated alcohol-free & smoking-free.
- Fire Safety:
 - -Open fires prohibited.
 - -Barbecuing is permitted in designated areas.

(Fire regulations prohibit operating barbecues or gas stoves in the hanger or vehicle storage buildings).

- -All combustible materials and supplies to be kept in designated place only.
- -Fire extinguishers must be located at fuel tanks at all times when refueling aircraft or vehicles.
- Ensure water hydrant is shut off at all times except when getting water supplies.
- Premises are to be kept clean and neat at all times. All garbage to be deposited in appropriate container and removed from the premises after each function. Leave area neater than you found it.
- Washroom facilities must be kept clean, which includes the main facility and the two outdoor toilet units.
- During Gliding Operations, the Netook Gliding Centre Commanding Officer or a designated representative will exercise control of all vehicles and personnel movement on the airfield.
- The Director is to be advised of all planned activities normally gliding and camping.
- The Netook Director must approve any changes or alterations to the facilities.
- Required repairs and/or damage to the facility to be reported to the Director.
- On departure, ensure all equipment (including sports equipment) is in its proper place, and all lights are off and doors are locked.
