### Welcome to Camp Wright

Camp Wright is a recreational lease property, owned and operated by the Air Cadet League of Canada, Alberta Provincial Committee. The prime purpose of this lease is to support training of the Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadrons located in Alberta.

The development of Camp Wright began in 1968. The Camp was named Camp Wright after Dr. Edwin Wright the resident doctor for Athabasca and one of the founders of this training area.

Our facility is located on approximately 122 hectares of wilderness. This Camp has been carefully planned to bring awareness of the natural environment and provide a training site for youth. Pease remember we are in the wilderness and must respect our surroundings and its inhabitants.

The Camp has the following facilities:

- A) Bill Chrusch Kitchen/ Dining room with cooking facilities and equipment. Tables and chairs for 130, deck facing the lake with picnic tables and propane BBQ. 3 sink manual dishwashing sink. AED in dining hall. Limited first aid equipment available.
- B) Washroom: Heated Male and Female, each with 3 toilets, 3 showers, and 5 sinks.
- C) Grassy area for sports and outdoor training. Four (4) portable toilets on site.
- D) Cabins: 9 (sleeping quarters) heated by electricity. Cabins have bunk beds with twin size mattress. 10 beds per unit total 90 persons
- E) Florence Skinner Staff Quarters: heated staff/volunteer building complete with a common area and washroom. Bedrooms contain double bunk beds, 2-4 beds per room. 6 rooms total 16 persons. Viewing deck facing the lake.
- F) Bill Bahry- Directors Cabin heated with common area, domestic kitchen, one bedroom, washroom. Useful for small group meetings or training groups.
- G) Waterfront: grassy beach, cook shed, BBQ pit and separate fire pit. Area great for canoeing, kayaking, sailing, paddle boarding, swimming. Great fishing, lake contains northern pike, walleye, yellow perch.
- H) Skinner Airfield makes a great training area for large groups tenting. Fire rings available. Range area available for archery and Air Rifle.
- I) Field space available for RV parking and/or tenting.

Our entire site and buildings are available for rent year-round, offering 35% discount rates for Monday – Thursday bookings.

Priority bookings for Canadian Cadet Organization – Royal Canadian Air Cadets, Royal Canadian Army Cadets and Royal Canadian Sea Cadets.

Excellent location for Youth Groups such as Beavers, Cubs and Scouts, Brownies and Guides, Church and School Groups. 20% discount is available for Non-Profit youth groups.

The facility is also available for Family Reunions, Weddings, Organizational retreats, fishing retreats, outdoor education retreats, etc.

We provide dish cloths & tea towels, kitchen equipment and serving utensils, toilet paper, garbage bags, cleaning supplies, limited amount of firewood.

You provide bedding, towels, toiletries, food, flashlight and personal first aid kits.

#### **CAMP WRIGHT STAFF**

Camp Wright is privileged to have dedicated volunteers (some former cadets) who have assisted in the restoration and maintenance of Camp Wright. If you are interested in joining this dedicated group of volunteers for short- or long-term projects, please contact the Director Camp Wright at any time. We are always looking for talented, skilled persons interested in the betterment of the facility.

The Camp Director or designate will identify themselves to the persons in charge upon arrival at Camp.

Camp Staff will maintain all facilities in good working standard and an environmentally safe training area to ensure your visit is a safe and enjoyable experience.

## **Camp Wright Regulations**

- Any cancellations under 30 days full charge will apply
- Any weather condition cancellations within 3 days, no charge will apply
- Booking deposit of \$250 is required for all users other than Cadet or Military groups. This
  deposit will be reimbursed once the camp has been designated as damage free and fully
  cleaned.
- Camp Wright Director/ designate may be in attendance during your stay at Camp.
- All users to provide an estimate time of arrival at time of booking.
- All users will be checked in and out by Camp Director/or designate. Users must let the Camp Director know who will be in charge and control while in attendance at Camp Wright. The assigned designate must be present at Camp Briefing for any questions.

### Requirements/Restrictions:

- All users will be aware of Camp Regulations posted in the Mess Hall.
- Users except Military/Cadet Corps and Squadrons must produce a certificate of Insurance to the Director prior to attendance of the Camp.
- Park all vehicles in the designated parking area.
- Off highway Vehicles (ATV's, Snowmobiles etc.) may be used for emergencies only at the discretion of the Camp Wright Director. Only existing trails may be used. Speed limit 10 km within Camp will be followed. The vehicle(s) and operation of must comply with ALBERTA REGULATION 319/2002 Traffic Safety Act OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE REGULATION.
- No Smoking within any Camp Building Smoking allowed only in designated Smoking Area
- <u>It is an offence</u> under the Alberta Safety Codes Act to tamper with any installed fire protection equipment (fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, CO detectors etc.).
- Only designated training sites and trails will be used. Site and Trail maps are available.
- **Absolutely no cutting** of live trees or stripping of conifers in the Camp or Training area. All grounds and training areas used will be cleaned of all debris before departure from Camp.
- No use of firearms, compound bows or pyrotechnics within Camp Wright boundaries.

- Due to excessive environmental damage no balloons, silly string etc. are allowed within Camp Wright boundaries.
- The only range site to be used is the designated range for archery and <u>air rifles only</u>.
- Swimming: It is the users' responsibility to ensure qualified supervision is always present.
- All fire regulations posted will be followed.
- Note Wildlife in the area (bears, moose, elk, deer, coyotes, wolves, beavers tec.) All food is
  to be kept in the Mess Hall, do not leave any garbage outside. Camp Wright is equipped with
  bear proof bins. <u>Please do not feed the wildlife</u>.
- No pets allowed within any Camp Wright Building owner is responsible to pick up after their pets.
- The user is responsible for cleaning all facilities. Cleaning supplies will be provided. Failure to leave the Camp in clean conditions will result in a cleaning levy of \$250. A Camp Wright clean up check list is posted in the Mess Hall.
- Garbage items that can be recycled by the user must be taken back with them (i.e pop cans, glass jars, cardboard etc.) Never leave garbage laying outside. Any garbage that can be condensed will be put in the garbage bin provided by Camp.
- The user will do a complete ground sweep for garbage.
- The user will not touch any equipment in Camp. If any maintenance problems are experienced the user must report it to the Camp Wright Director/designate immediately.
- Any damages will be billed directly to the user.
- Camp Wright Fire Orders are posted in the Dining Room, Florence Skinner and Bill Bahry buildings. Make sure you read and follow these orders.




